in honour of Ed Romanowski

<b>Donor</b>	<p><b>Mr. Romanowski has provided the initial endowment for this award.</b> Additional contributions will be provided through the fundraising initiatives of The CFS Endowment Society. Ed Romanowski is a parent at Calgary French &amp; International School who has truly gone “The Extra Mile” for this educational institution. He served as Vice President of Facilities for CFIS from 2000 through 2006, and an Executive, Finance and Facilities Committee Member for the Foundation Board. Mr. Romanowski was instrumental in leading the team of dedicated parents and school administrators that oversaw the site selection, acquisition, financing, planning, design, contracting and construction of the school over six years. Construction of the school was completed in two phases: the south wing in the summer of 2003 and the north wing in the spring of 2005. Both phases were completed on time and under budget. In honour of Ed’s tremendous efforts, unceasing energy and selflessness, the Foundation had the actual running shoes he wore on site to build this school bronzed as part of the presentation for this award. Ed, his wife Alice, and son Ryan, regularly participated and did well in the Annual Madame Lorraine 5 km Run.</p>

<b>Eligibility</b>	<p><b>Open to candidates who are registered at Calgary French &amp; International School who have demonstrated going “The Extra Mile” for CFIS and the community at large.</b></p> <p><b>The recipient will exhibit the following traits:</b></p> <p><b>Perseverance:</b> Never giving up in the face of adversity. Shows a determination, but is not necessarily among the top performers, in academics, athletics and community work.</p> <p><b>Stamina:</b> An unlimited supply of energy for self and others. Enduring, resilient and strong.</p> <p><b>Academic Achievement:</b> A good student, but not necessarily at top of the class.</p> <p><b>Initiative:</b> Knows what needs to be done and when. This student is inventive and plans and completes projects with little or no guidance.</p> <p><b>Community Involvement:</b> A student not only giving to the school community, but actively involved in extra-curricular activities in the broader community.</p>
